

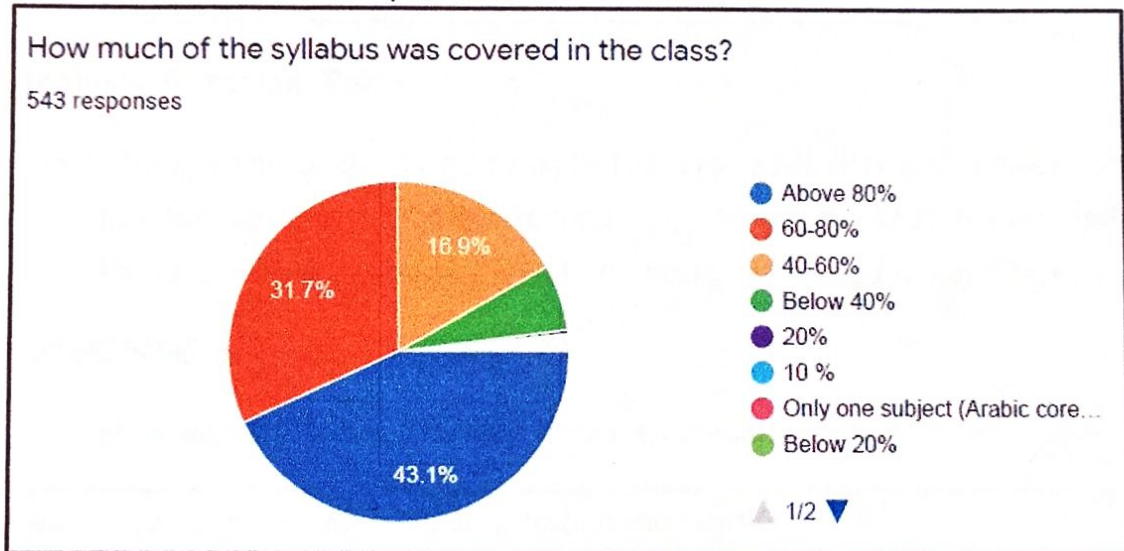

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT

A meeting of all the Heads of various departments and member of IQAC was organised in the IQAC on 12-10-2021 under the chairmanship of Prof Sarshad Hussain, Co-ordinator IQAC in connection with analysis of students' feedback and recommendation of action to be taken by the chair for the implementation. Following points were discussed and resolved unanimously:

RESPONSE 1

- How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



Analysis & Action Taken

- From the pie chart it is clear that less than 50% responses are indicating coverage of syllabus is 80%. At the same time it is not clear that which subjects have not attained the reasonable coverage.
- Hence it is recommended that next time teacher-wise/subject-wise feedback may be taken to identify the same so that necessary initiatives may be taken. In addition, all the heads are informed to look into the matter.







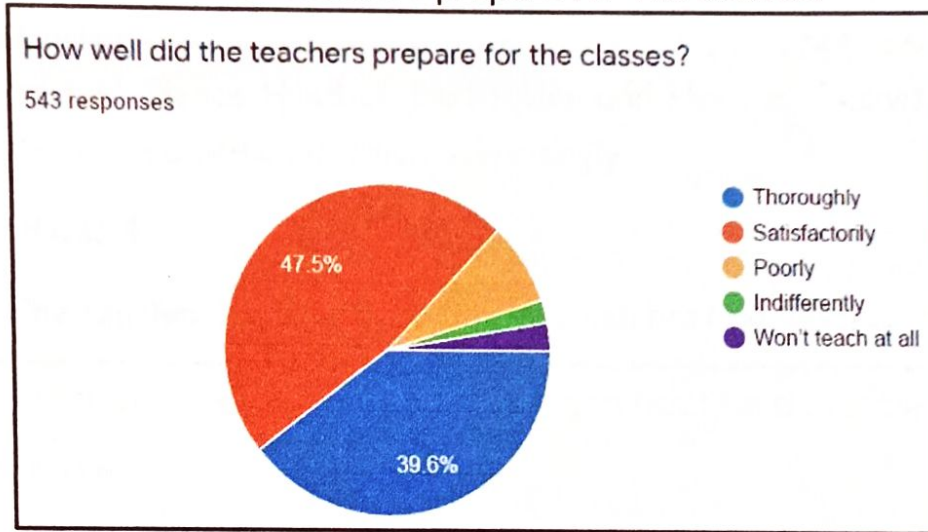






RESPONSE 2

- How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

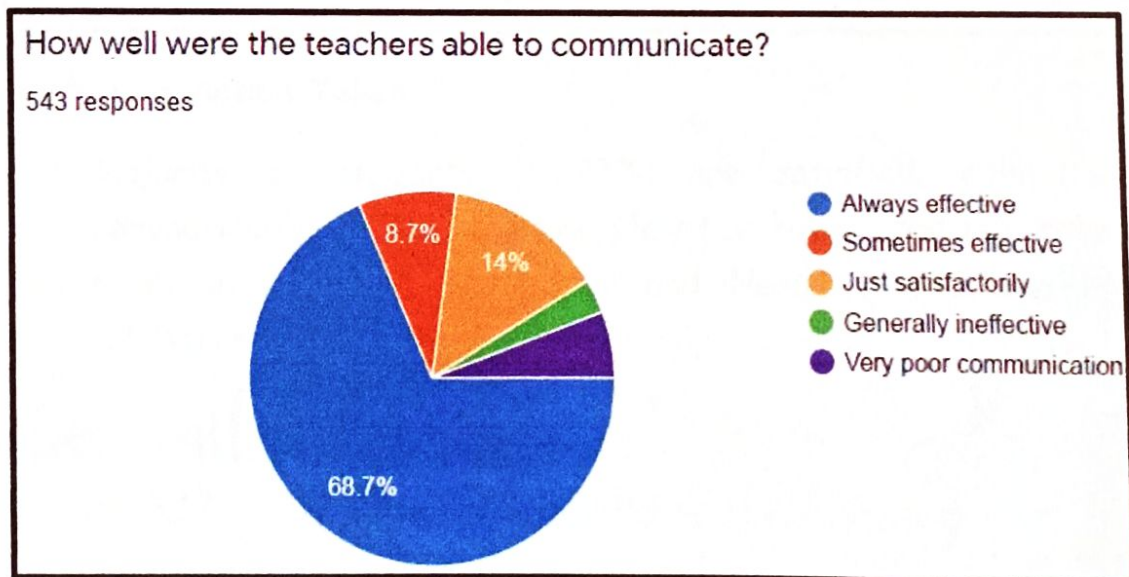


Analysis & Action Taken

- How well were the teachers able to communicate?



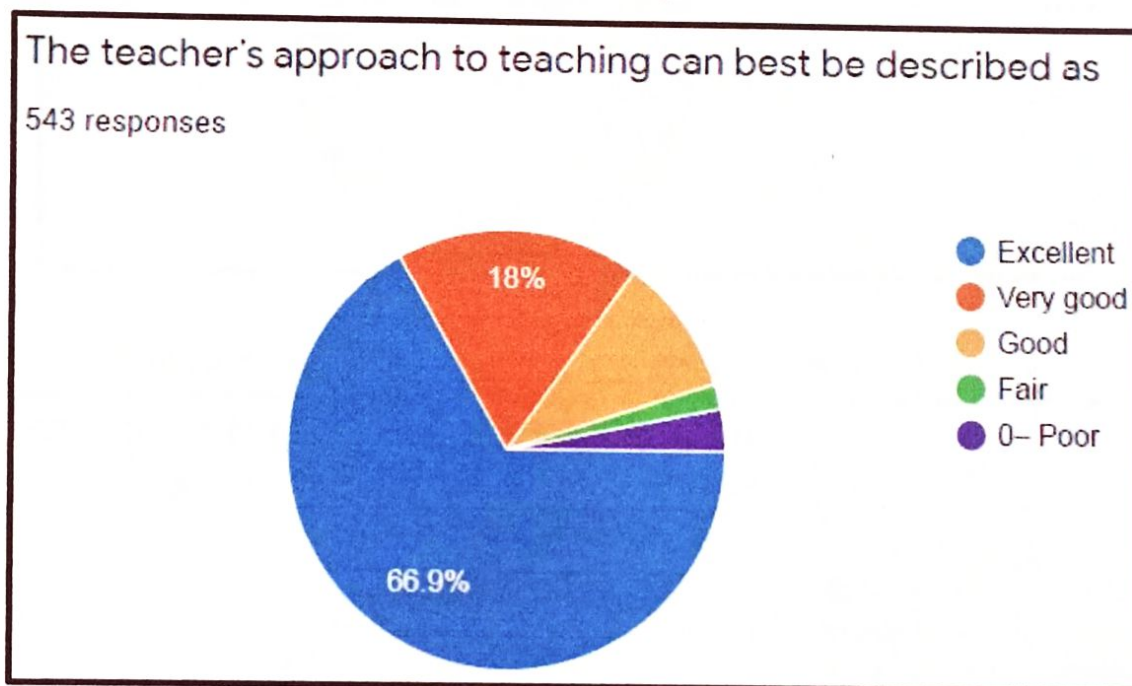
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Analysis & Action Taken

- The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as:



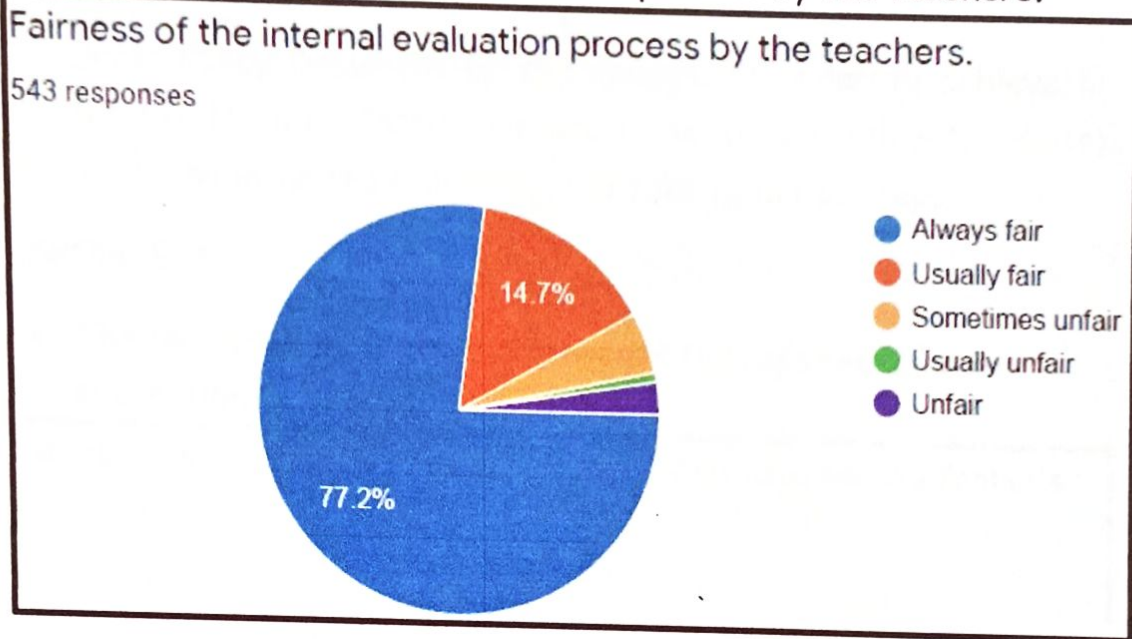
Analysis & Action Taken

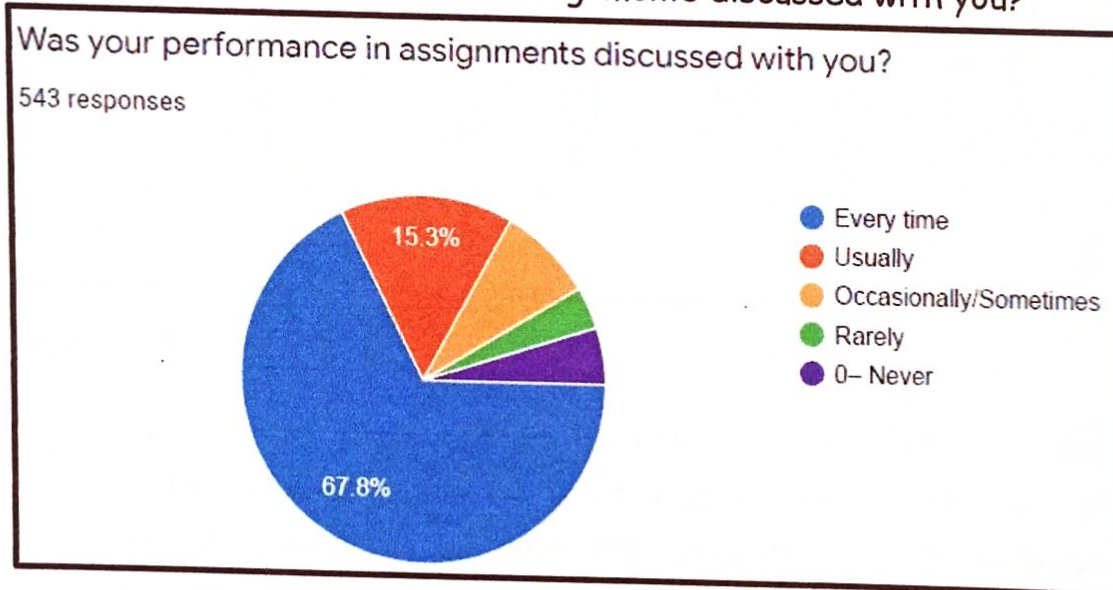
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RESPONSE 5& 6

Analysis & Action Taken

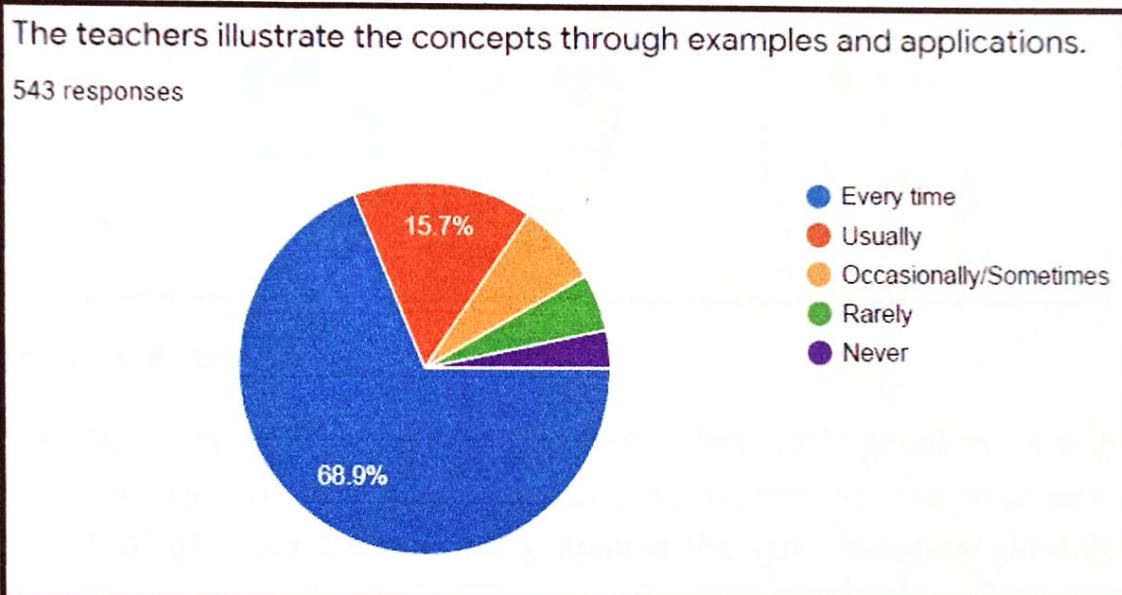
- A good number of students are satisfied with evaluation system of the College. 77% of students are of the opinion that the internal evaluation process by the teachers is always fair

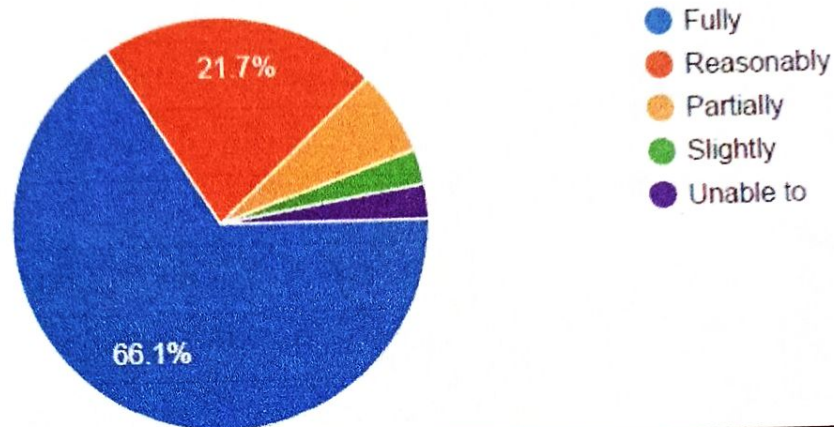
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RESPONSE 8

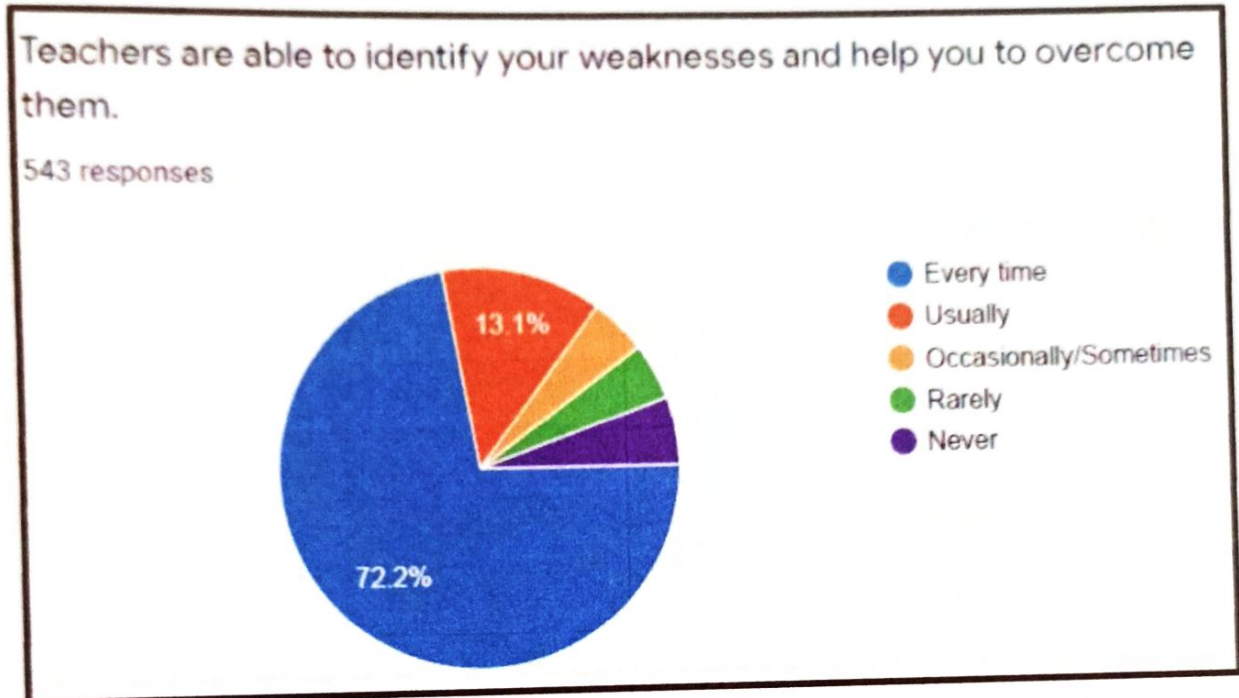
Analysis & Action Taken

- Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



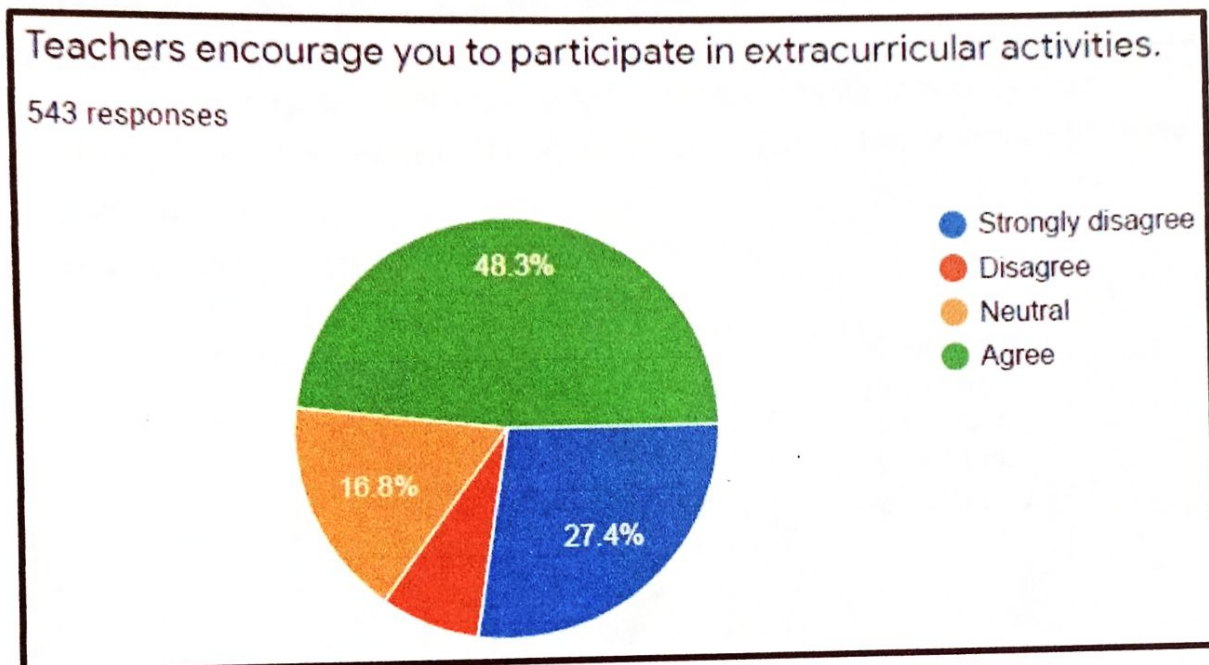
Analysis & Action Taken

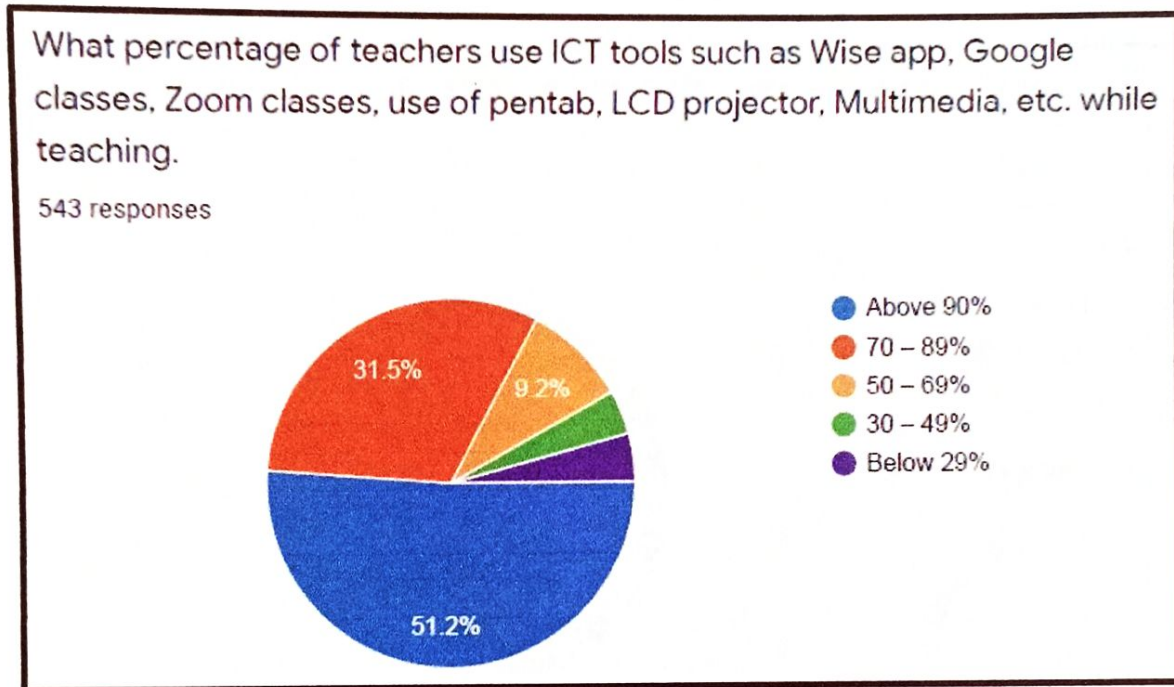

What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as Wise app, google classes, zoom classes, use of pentab, LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?



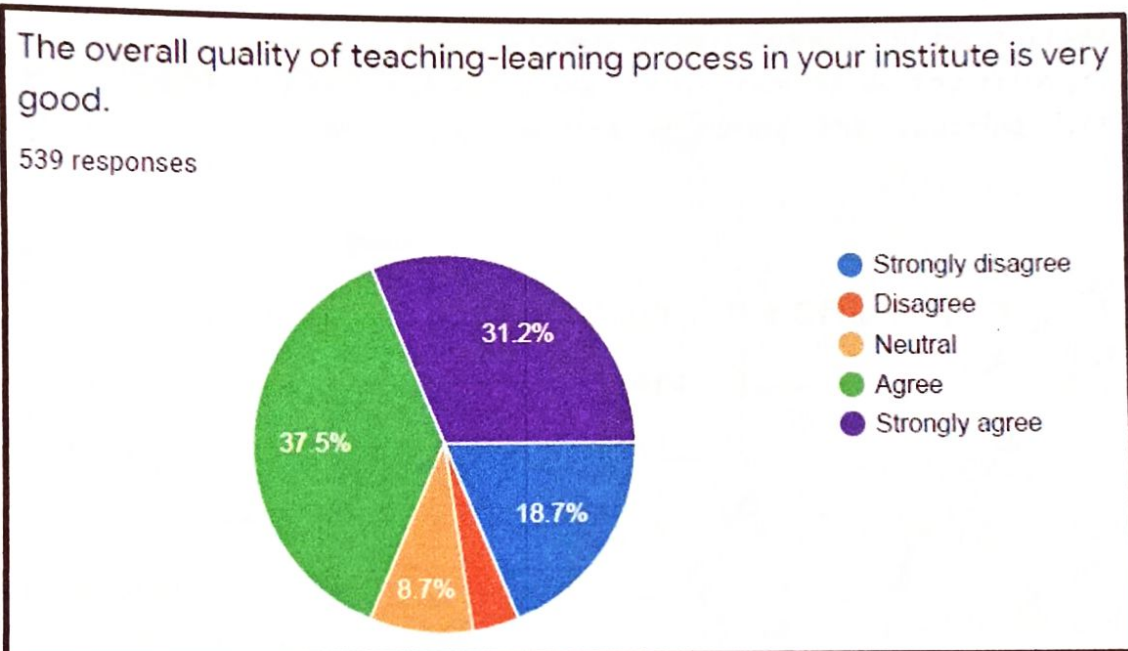
Analysis & Action Taken
