TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT

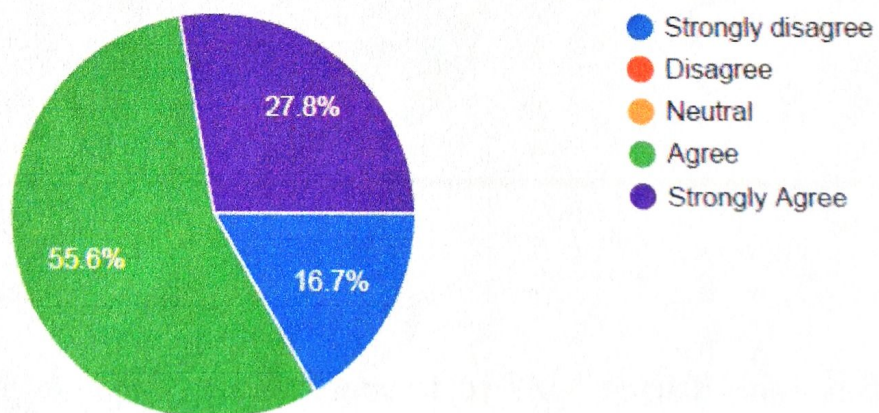

Analysis & Action Taken

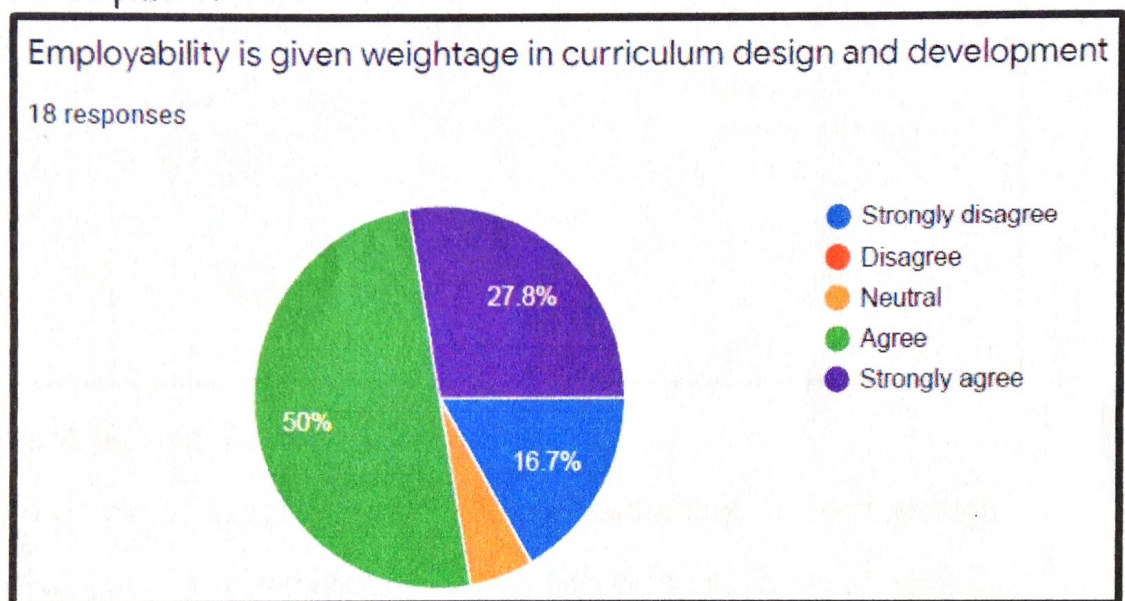

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also clear that there are some minor grievances as majority have not gone with strongly agree. Hence it is recommended that all members of BoS either communicate their grievances to the concerned Head of Department of University of Jammu in writing for redressal or to IQAC for forwarding it through proper channel.

- Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development?



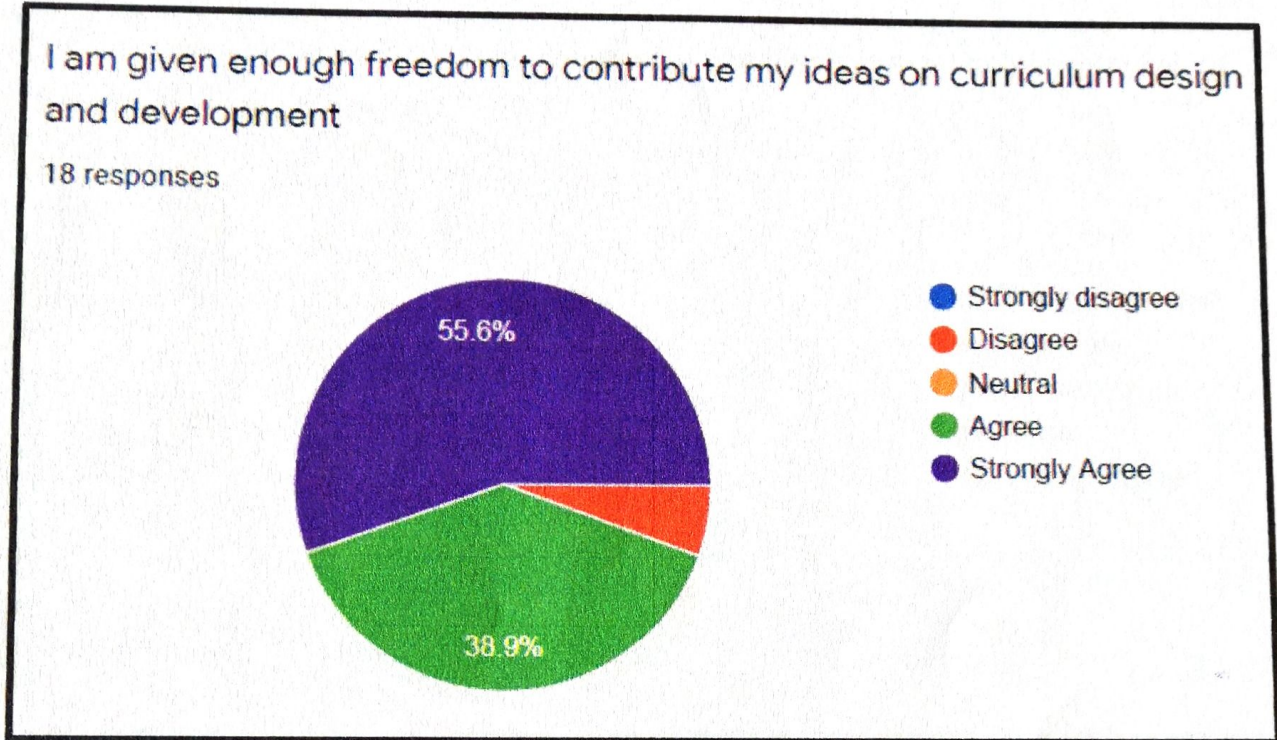
Analysis & Action Taken

- I am given enough freedom to contribute my ideas on curriculum design and development?



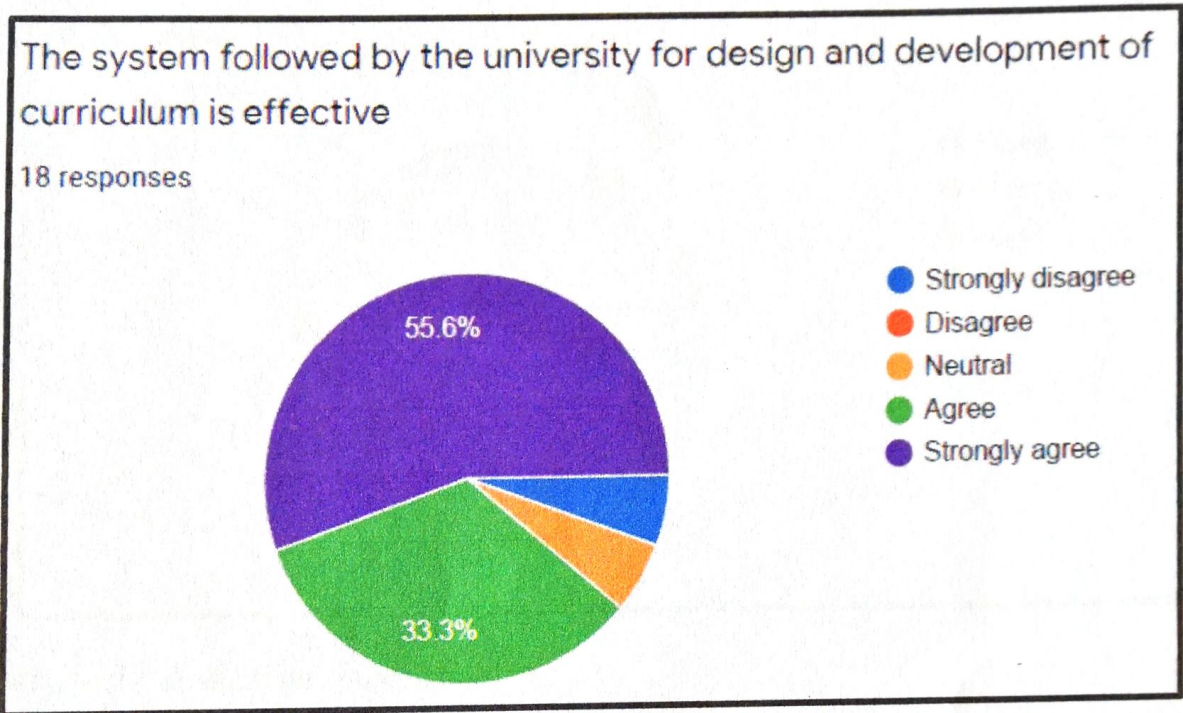
Analysis & Action Taken

- System followed by university for design and development of curriculum is effective?



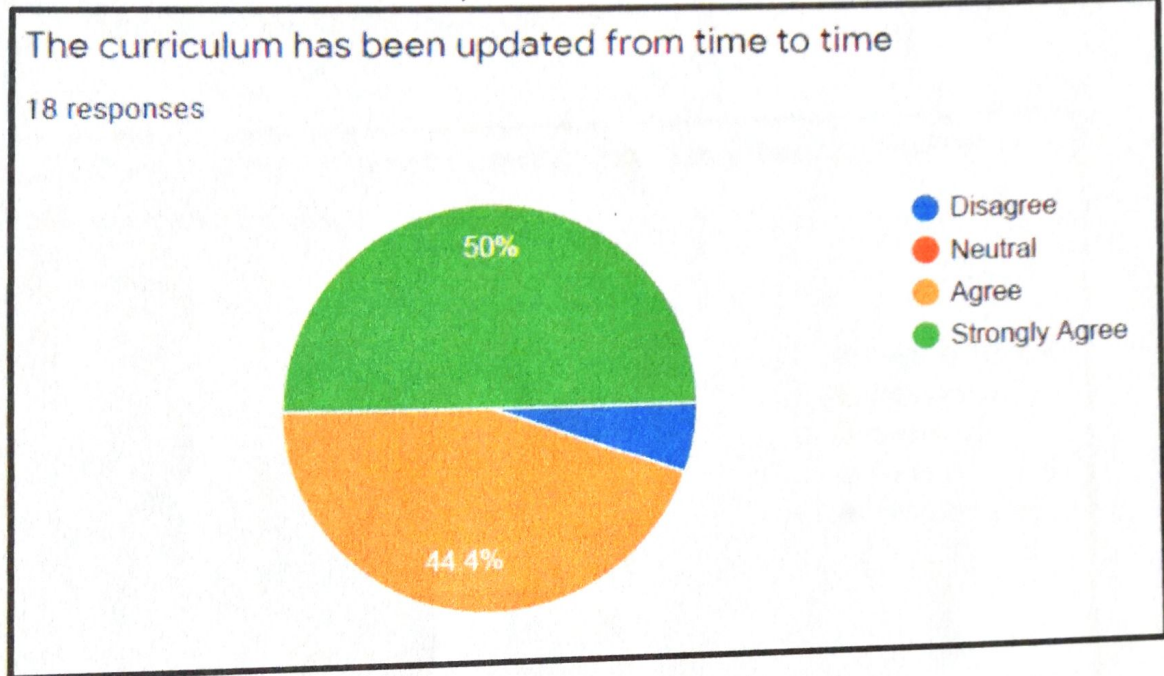
Analysis & Action Taken

- Curriculum has been updated from time to time.



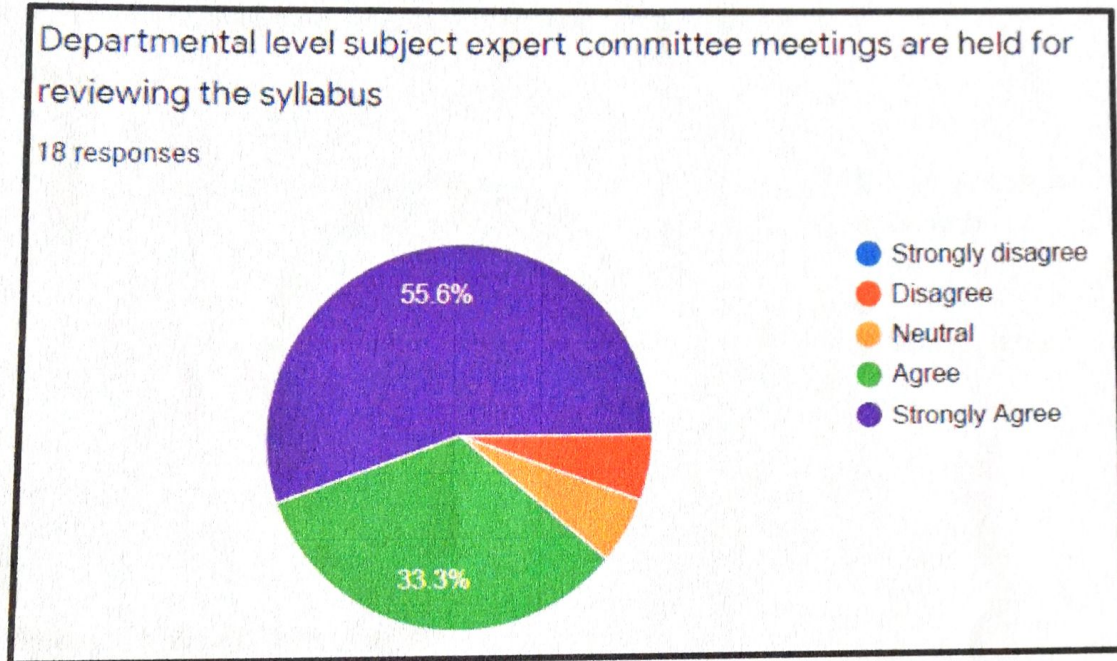
Analysis & Action Taken

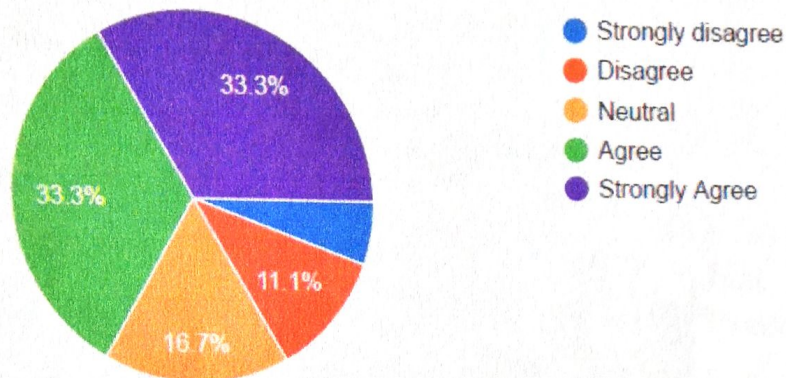
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RESPONSE 7
