
ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT

51 responses




• Analysis & Action Taken

From the pie chart it is clear that 98% (good + very good + excellent) of the alumni are with the courses taught in the college. Hence no action is needed.

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RESPONSE 2




- Analysis & Action Taken**

From the pie chart it is clear that 88% (good + very good + excellent) of the alumni are satisfied with lab facilities. It is also clear that college has shifted to its own building in 2019 and thereafter it remained closed for maximum period due to Covid-19 pandemic. So, less response is obvious. Now it has good facilities of laboratories the response of which shall be received here onwards. Hence no action is needed.

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RESPONSE 3




- Analysis & Action Taken**

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









RESPONSE 5



- Analysis & Action Taken**










RESPONSE 7




